



**Online Conference of Global Terrorists this Weekend**  
**CSC Press Release, 28 July 2010**

**Convicted terrorists and Islamist hate preachers are regularly using internet chat forums and websites registered to the US and Australia to circumvent anti-terrorism measures.**

On 31 July 2010 the internet chat service Paltalk will host convicted terrorists and members of proscribed organisations in an online conference session titled "Ghazwatal Washington" [The Battle of Washington]. The event, streamed through Paltalk [chat room](#) "Authentic Tawheed", is [advertised](#) as follows:

*Authentic Tawheed presents a global conference  
 Ghazwatal Washington – CONFERENCE*

*We shall examine the current war against Islam and Muslims and ask for how much longer can the kuffar be able to fight against the deen of Islam and the necessary steps needed for victory*

*Topic 1 –the American Crusade by Younus Abdullah (Revolution Muslim)*

*Topic 2 – The Failure of the plots of Kufar by Anjem Choudary*

*Topic 3 – Steps towards victory by Abu Waleed*

*Topic 4 – History repeats itself by Sheikh Abdullah Faisal*

*Topic 5 – Conquest of Washington by Sheikh Omar Bakri Muhammad*

The websites streaming the event live include salafimedia.com (registered in the US), revolutionmuslim.com (based in the US) and authentictawheed.com (registered in Australia). Downloadable audio files and books available on these websites include those by:

- **Anwar al-Awlaki:** wanted by the US government in connection to the Fort Hood shootings and attempted Christmas Day airline bombing
- **Abu Hamza al-Masri:** convicted in the UK for soliciting to murder and currently fighting extradition to the US
- **Abu Qatada:** al-Qaeda ideologue currently detained in the UK fighting deportation to Jordan
- **Yusuf al ‘Uyayree:** al-Qaeda ideologue and global jihad strategist; author of ‘Constants on the Path of Jihad’
- **Bilal Ameenah Phillips:** recently banned from entering the UK because of hate speech
- **Abdullah el-Faisal:** Convicted in the UK of soliciting to murder and incitement to racial hatred in 2003 and deported to Jamaica in 2007
- **Omar Bakri Mohammad:** Former leader of the proscribed group al-Muhajiroun and convicted *in absentia* in Lebanon in 2009 of providing weapons training to a terrorist group

**Douglas Murray, Centre for Social Cohesion Director, says:**

"Anti-terrorism measures are used to convict hate preachers and stop incitement to terrorism by proscribing organisations as well as barring individuals from entering the UK. However, these same hate preachers can use websites registered outside the UK with impunity. Chat rooms are increasingly being used to interact with listeners and to disseminate a violent Islamist ideology from virtually any country. Governments worldwide need to develop policies to combat this threat."
